



Webster Dudley Oxford Chamber of Commerce **Academic Scholarship Application**

In accordance with our ideals of awarding graduating seniors of the towns of Webster, Dudley and Oxford, the Webster Dudley Oxford Chamber of Commerce will award scholarships to assist students who wish to continue in their first year of accredited post secondary school education. Proceeds from the Annual Webster Dudley Oxford Chamber of Commerce Golf Tournament and other fundraisers benefit this scholarship.

One scholarship in either Academic or a Career/Trade will be awarded in the amount of \$1,500 to a student at each of the following schools: Bartlett High, Shepherd Hill High, Oxford High and Bay Path Regional Vocational Technical High School. Scholarships will be awarded according to the following criteria.

Criteria

1. Applicants must reside in the towns of Webster, Dudley or Oxford and plan to attend an accredited post secondary school and are current students of Bartlett High, Shepherd Hill High, Oxford High or Bay Path Regional Vocational Technical High School.
2. Applicants must be in the top 50% of their graduating class. Transcript of school grades must accompany application.
3. Scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic achievement, community and school involvement.
4. All forms must be complete and include an essay as outlined, transcript, and three (3) letters of recommendation from a teacher, guidance counselor, employer or member of your clergy.
5. **Application deadline is Friday, April 14, 2023.** Applications postmarked later than the deadline will not be considered.
6. Finalists may be asked to participate in a personal interview with the scholarship committee.
